



Call for Board Nominations

The NHNSA board is seeking to fill one (1) vacant board positions for a three-year (2026-2029) term. Skilled members must have a desire to advocate on behalf of the membership to address barriers and collaborate on practical, evidence-based solutions that inform improvements and support the long-term care sector in Nova Scotia.

Criteria for NHNSA Board of Directors

- Meet the requirements set out in the NHNSA's by-laws and board policy.
- Represent diverse perspectives from a variety of ethnic, language, gender, and cultural identities.
- Representation from four geographic zones, urban/rural mix.
- Represent diverse operational models that include not-for-profit, for-profit, and municipal ownership.
- Comprised of administrators and senior leaders.
- Reflect relative skills outlined in the Board Skills Matrix, eg.

Candidate Criteria:

- Be an active primary member of NHNSA
- Be able to attend monthly board meetings (virtual- two hour), along with quarterly membership meetings (hybrid- virtual/onsite) in March, June and September, December, along with special meetings and events, as required.

Submission Criteria

In writing (email) to a member of the nominating committee or NHNSA Executive Director, please submit the following information:

- Provide name and position within your organization
- Relative skills you bring to the board role (Preference will be given to members who have a background in financial, legal, and / or labour management experience to help round out the current board mix.)
- Area of interest in advocacy
- Letter of reference from your administrator if you are a senior leader
